### ***Parental Escort Policy***

*The Parental Escort Policy (PEP) at Mall of America® changed from 6 p.m. to 4 p.m. on October 7, 2005. While everyone is welcome at Mall of America, a Parental Escort Policy implemented in 1996 requires younger guests (under age 16) be accompanied by an adult 21 years or older on Friday and Saturday evenings after 4 p.m.*
